Plenary Indulgence when visiting the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain defined conditions through the Church's help.

A plenary (meaning "full") indulgence is a special type of indulgence that, if all the requirements are met, removes **all** temporal punishment due to one's sin. The church uses the power of the keys given to St. Peter by Jesus in Scripture (Matthew 16:18) to remove temporal consequences that still remain from sins committed. Even if we have been forgiven of a particular sin, we still experience the consequences of that sin in our lives.

The faithful who devoutly visit the Basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's Prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions:

Sacramental Confession
Eucharistic Communion (Holy Mass)
Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father

On the following occasions;

December 8th - The anniversary of the dedication of the Parish of the Immaculate Conception.
The parish was a mission Church from 1845 to 1854.

June 29th – The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

June 21st – The anniversary of the official granting of the title of "minor basilica"
